

COURSE POLICES

Hosting a Course

There is no cost to agencies/organizations for hosting a course. For security reasons, host agencies/organizations may reserve the right to refuse attendance to students who are not employed by a police or government organization.

Cancellation

Forza Forensics understands that you may have to cancel your registration for a course. We ask that you contact us at least **14 calendar days** prior to the first day of the course to obtain a full refund. Please send a cancellation email to **info@forzaforensics.com**. Refunds are not available for cancellations made after the **14** calendar day period, however the student will receive credit towards a future class to be used within one year from the course date. The credit may be transferred to another person by emailing **info@forzaforensics.com** and providing the new student's information.

No Show

If a student does not cancel and does not show to a course by the first day, no refund or credit will be issued. Any pending invoices for that student's registration will remain open and need to be paid.
